

# How do you show the love?

5 impertinent questions to help you supercharge what's possible

#### IMPERTINENT QUESTIONS

## When have you felt the love?

Noticing when, how and where you've *felt* the love can help identify how you show it. So get curious about that feeling. How did you experience it? What was the vibe, which qualities were to the fore? How did you respond? What did that love enable in you?

#### IMPERTINENT QUESTIONS

## How do you show the love?

Showing the love involves being more, not doing more. So get curious about how you're being. What are you dialling up or down? What feeling does that communicate? What is the nature of the response? What does it enable in everyone else? How does it feel in you?



Where is your difference your distinction?

Who are you at full beam? What does your extra mile look like? How is that not like the norm? How valuable is that norm? Where are you so extra that you squash everyone else? (Best avoided.) Showing the love isn't bland. It's special. It's distinct. It's you.

### IMPERTINENT QUESTIONS

How might you be more intentional?

Showing the love isn't inadvertent; it's purposeful. But a lack of clarity can diminish that intention. So get curious about how can you channel that clarity. What might you need to think, do or have – for yourself or from others? What might help you stay courageously consistent?

### IMPERTINENT QUESTIONS

## Where does it feel risky?

Showing the love is a risk. There's vulnerability in showing up full beam you when you can't guarantee the response. Get curious about that risk. When does it feel risky – and not? What might be gained from embracing it – or lost? Whose loss or gain might that be?

## Get curious about the love

Showing the love is a leadership superpower. One that channels feeling over doing to supercharge what's possible. It's not easy, and it's not for everything: it's special; it's extra. And it's intensely personal. So get curious: how do you show the love?
